We are preparing the 2024 for Annual Business Meeting, which will be held at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 25th, 2024, at the P1FCU Administration Center located at 1025 Warner Avenue in Idaho. Lewiston. The fourth quarter

newsletter you will receive in January of 2024 will have all the updated Annual Business Meeting information and additional voting information for the annual election of Board Members.

The Board of Directors has approved a slate of board candidates submitted by our Board Secretary after the approval of the slate by our Board Nominating Committee. The credit union's bylaws permit nominations for vacancies by petition signed by 1% of the members with a maximum of five hundred member signatures. The election will not be conducted by ballot, and there will be no nominations from the floor when there is only one nominee for each position to be filled. Nominations by petition will be accepted until December 15th, 2023, in accordance with our bylaws. You can contact me at the credit union for further information about this process. Members may vote online Monday, January 8th, 2024, through Thursday, January 25th, 2024, in-branch by ballot box starting from January 8th, 2024, and ending January 25th, 2024, by paper ballot by requesting a ballot with ballots to be received by January

25th, 2024, and voting is allowed at the Annual Business Meeting for members who have not yet voted. The minimum age for qualification to vote and hold an elective office is eighteen.
