



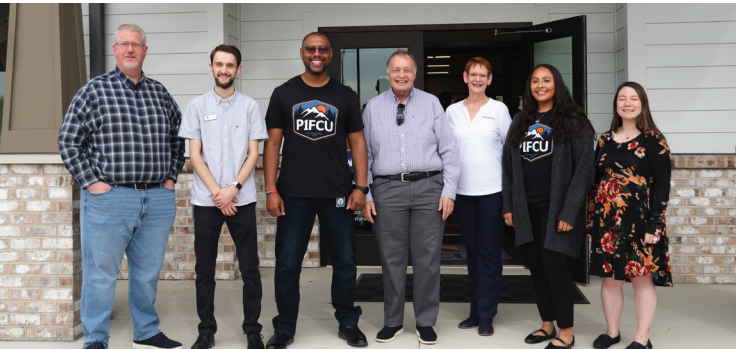

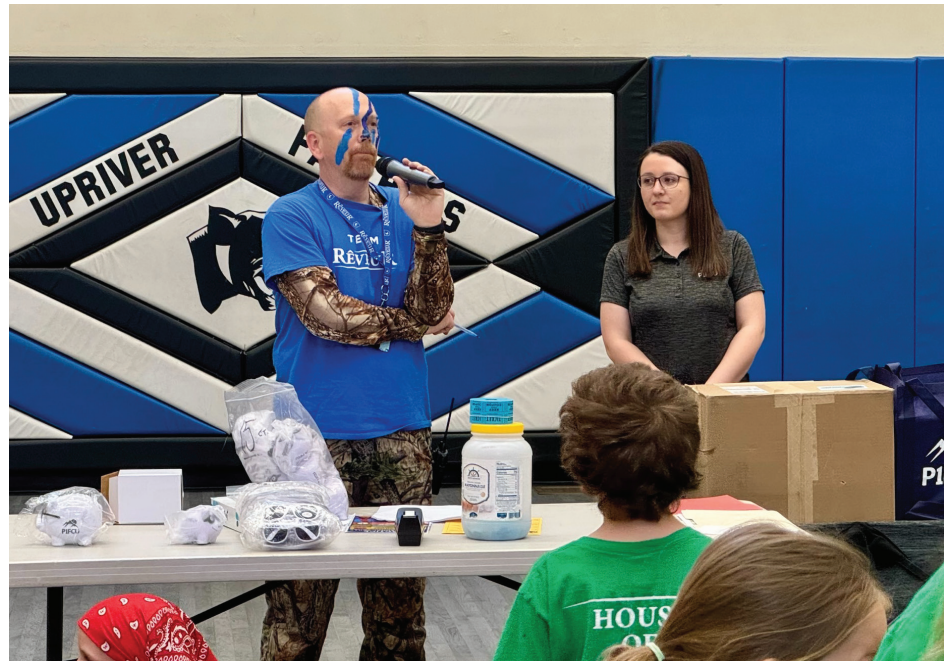
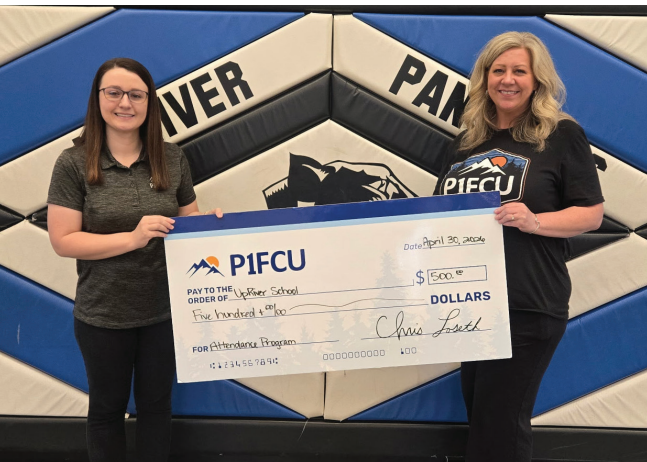

The program encourages positive attendance habits and student engagement, helping create a supportive and encouraging environment for students throughout the school year.



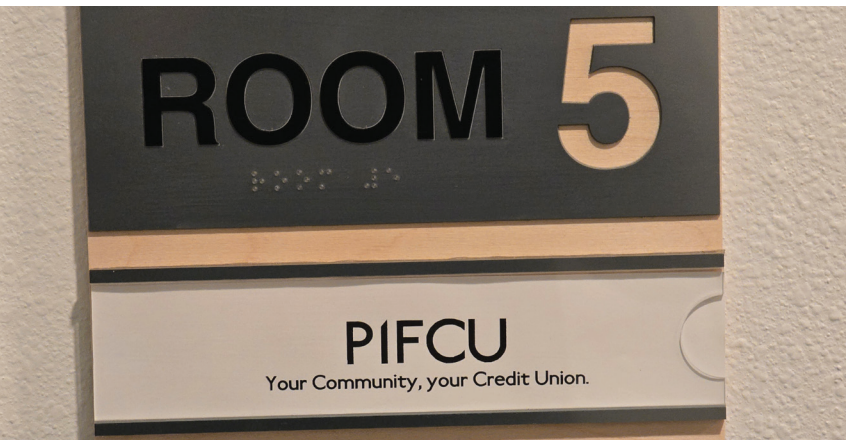
Putt Putt for a Purpose
