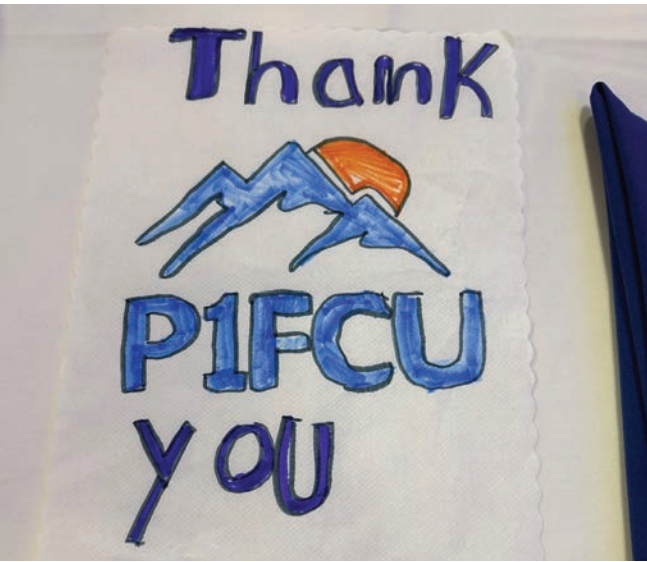

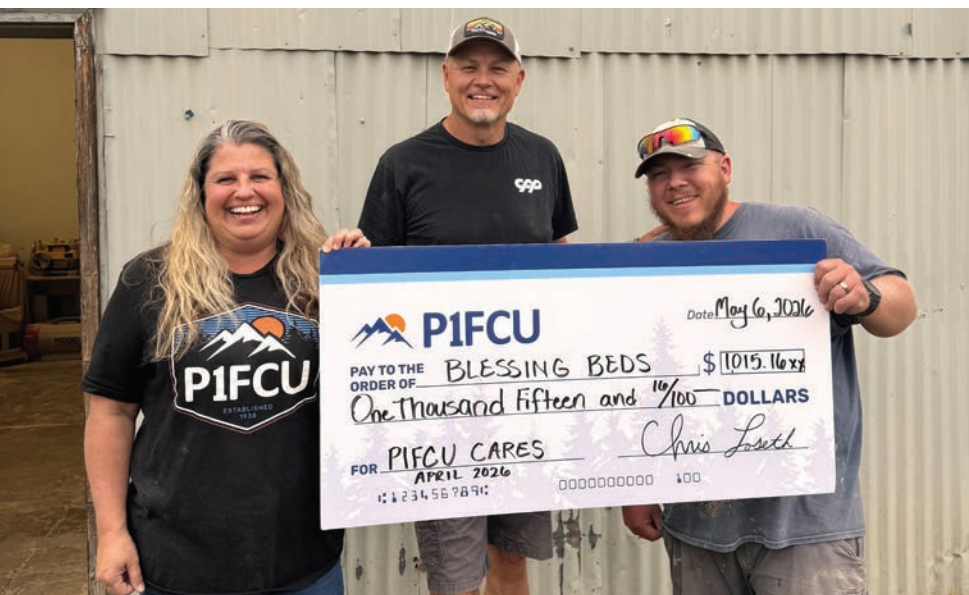
Acts of Kindness
