#### **New Hire Orientation - Idaho Foodbank**



#### United Way of the Blue Mountains - Dolly Parton's Imagination Library



#### **Turkeys and More**


We were honored to support Turkeys and More again this year. The program's goal is to make Thanksgiving meals a reality for local families in need.
