## We Love a Parade!

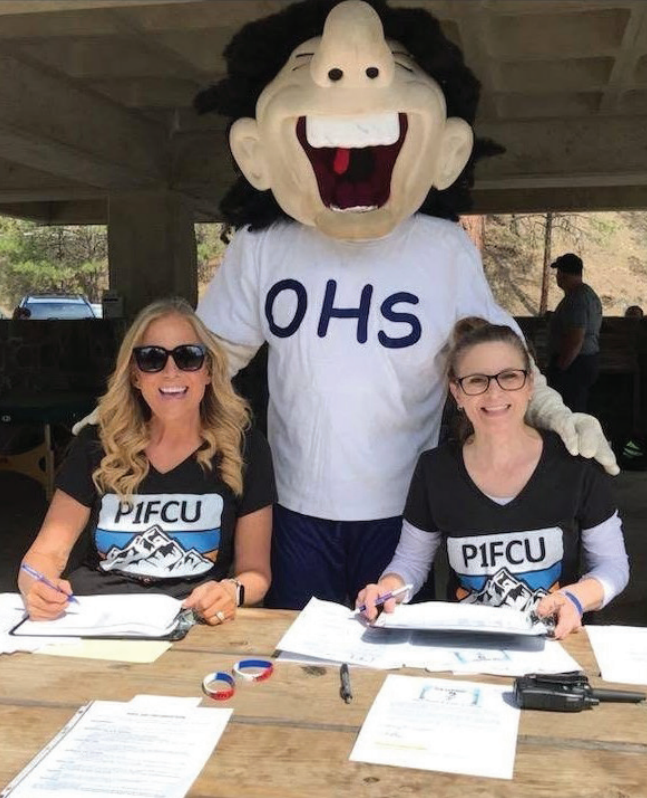
