

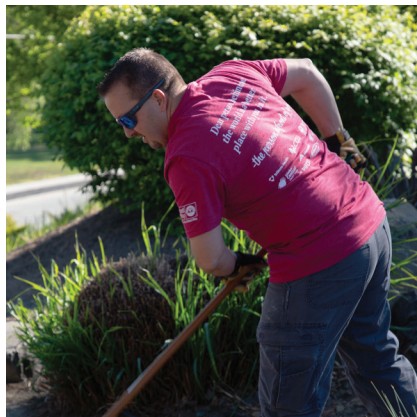

Food Bank New Hire Day

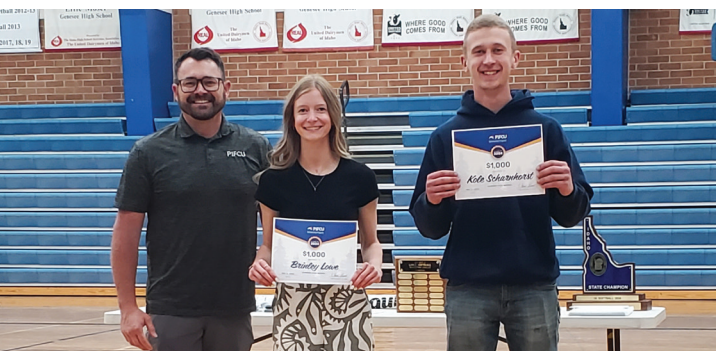
