We will be electing four board members in 2024. We will elect three board members for 3-year terms and one board member for a 1-year term. Our board of directors meets the third

Wednesday of each month for board meetings, holds quarterly committee meetings, and has several training opportunities throughout the year. Board members participate in training to stay ahead of the ever-changing financial world.


