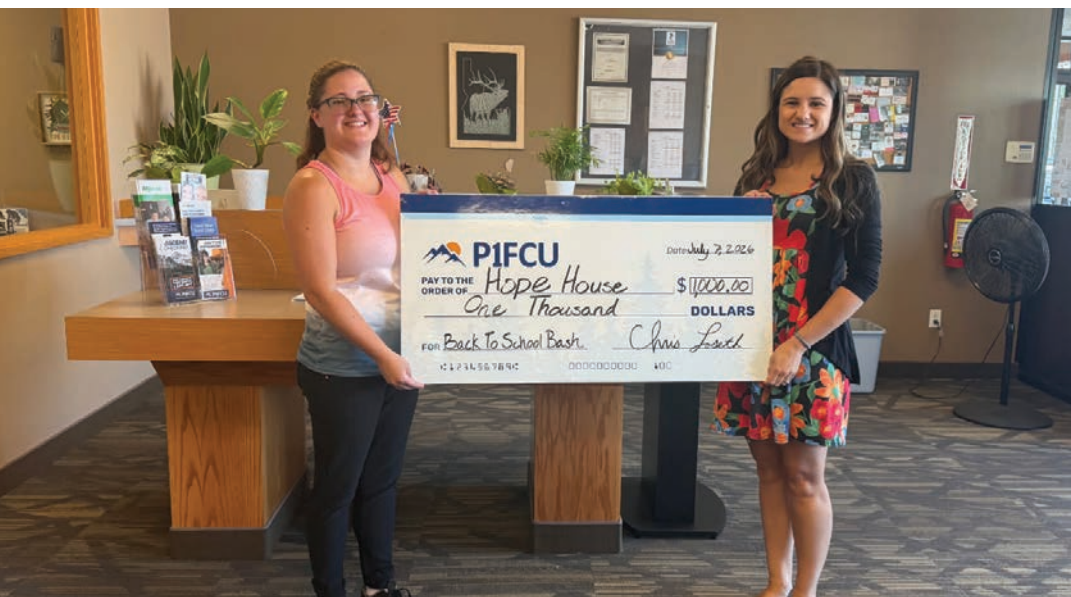
Sunshine & Sound Bites
